### **Oversight Board**

Independently Chaired, the Oversight Board is made up of government, regulator, and industry representatives, our Air Navigation Service Provider, Representatives from our Consultative Committee, Community Member Attendees, the Independent Community Representative, London Gatwick representative, Expert Advisory Group, and the Programme Steering Group lead. The Oversight Board is the accountability authority over the Community Assembly and the Programme Steering Group. It is here that all noise related concerns, ideas, and projects are discussed and developed.

#### Community Assembly

Chaired by the Independent Community Representative, the Community Assembly is a place for our community members to come together to discuss noise related thoughts, ideas, and concerns. The Expert Advisors are also on hand to give subject specific information and guidance, and answer any airspace and noise questions our members might have. Discussions, requests, and key thoughts will be taken to the Oversight Board for wider discussion via the Independent Community Representative.

## **Programme Steering Group**

The core principles of the PSG are to keep the projects on track; bring together the priorities of industry, communities, and London Gatwick, to deliver balanced projects, which are beneficial to all; and realising project benefits and integrating them into industry upon completion.



The Project Steering Group Matrix of Consultation




