2.	<b>Expert Advisory Group Introductions</b> - Rachel Thomas - Douglas Moule - Professor Paul Hooper	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Key headlines from the FED report, delivered by Prof. Paul Hooper:               <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>o It focused on exploring responses to virtual scenarios.</li> <li>o Communities had a strong preference to minimal change that did not differ too far from the current situation.</li> <li>o Sensitivity being highest for low exposure areas.</li> </ul> </li> </ul> <p>It should be noted that for all other FED discussions and queries, FED briefings have been scheduled for January 2025. These will be given by the FED team and attended by the London Gatwick Airspace Modernisation team. The FED project is not directly an NMB project.</p>
3.	<b>Overview of 2025</b> - Reminder of Community Assembly meeting structure - Contribution to wider NMB	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Meetings will be held quarterly, 2 weeks before the Oversight Board.</li> <li>- Attendance to the Community Assembly is a prerequisite for attending the Oversight Board.</li> <li>- Community Assembly's are where all members get to discuss agenda topics and raise thoughts/queries. Whilst Community Assembly members are welcome, attendance at Oversight Board will not provide additional/new information and is not necessary to have concerns/opinions heard.</li> </ul>
4.	<b>Programme Steering Group</b> - Projects overview - Project control sheets - Briefings and Workshops	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- The 6 shortlisted projects were presented as initial and provisional ideas.</li> <li>- CA members noted that the projects need to identify <u>what</u> is being targeted by each project (SMART targets).</li> <li>- Previous NMB projects should have updates, potentially as a briefing.</li> <li>- Some projects may be able to be combined as 'active' and 'passive' projects.</li> <li>- FED presents an opportunity for further work for the NMB.</li> <li>- There could be a more ambitious project that utilises FED in some way.</li> </ul>
5.	<b>AOB</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Operational challenges are a potential idea for an educational briefing.</li> <li>- FED Briefing will be held on Thursday 23 and Monday 27 January, and additionally, RNN briefings are to be held around this time.</li> </ul>
